WHEREAS, the City of Fountain Valley honors the Inland Empire Branch of the International Dyslexia Association and all organizations which provide services for learners who struggle; and


WHEREAS, these nonprofit organizations render support to families experiencing significant literacy issues as a result of a dyslexic pattern in one or more family members; and
